You may want to change your wireless password so to do this you need to:

- 3. To check you are connecting to the correct router you will see the router model number shown in the first sentence of the logon screen. See pointed out in the image above.
 - Click on Configuration
 - Click on Wireless
 - Click on Security
- 4. Change the WPA/WAPI Passphrase to your desired password.
